

Follow the Transhumance in the Lot Valley

The last two week-ends of May, Transhumance festivals are taking place in Aveyron, Cantal and Lozère.

The transhumance of the herds up to the mountain summer pasture is always a crucial moment for life on the Aubrac, which takes place to the tune of festivals and get togethers.

It's also a great opportunity to celebrate spring to the sound of the bells of the Aubrac cows (they're the ones that look like they have khôl eye-liner): herd decoration, milking demonstration, local market, traditional bands, gastronomy ... it's at Saint-Geniez (Aveyron) on the 22nd and 23rd of May with accommodation in guest houses or in chalets with local speciality meals provided on Saturday evenings.
